


WHO WE ARE

The Mediation Centre offers specialized mediation services for families who are involved with The Children's Aid Society.





CHILD PROTECTION MEDIATION

Child protection mediation is available free of charge to all families involved with a Children's Aid Society. In this process, the mediator works with the family, their worker and other involved people to assist in the development of a plan that is acceptable to all.

Child protection Mediation can take place at any time, before or after court is involved. Sometimes court dates can be moved to allow child protection to take place.

Child protection is voluntary and the participants have to consent to participate. Mediation is a confidential process, but if a plan is worked out, this plan can be presented to the court.
